

AN ORDINANCE OF LIBERTY TOWNSHIP, MONTOUR COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, PROHIBITING DUMPING IN AND ALONG THE STREETS, ROADS AND HIGHWAYS SITUATE IN LIBERTY TOWNSHIP, MONTOUR COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.

The Board of Supervisors of Liberty Township, Montour County, Pennsylvania, hereby enacts and ordains as follows:--

SECTION 1: Pursuant to the provisions contained in the Township Code, and in order to carry the said provisions into effect, the hereinafter set forth provisions shall become effective.

SECTION 2: No house refuse, offal, garbage, dead animals, decaying vegetable matter or organic waste substance of any kind shall be thrown on any street, alley, road, highway, ditch and/or gutter within the limits of this Township.

SECTION 3: Person shall be any natural person, association, partnership, firm or corporation.

SECTION 4: Any person, association, partnership, firm or corporation violating the provisions of the ordinance shall be subject to fine to a maximum of Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) for each violation together with the costs of prosecution.

SECTION 5: All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed.
