1. Call to Order - The meeting was called to order by Chairman, Joel Rine at 7:30m pm.
2. The Minutes for August 11, 202 meeting were reviewed. Upon motion by Richard Jones, seconded by John Esenwein the minutes of that meeting were approved unanimously.
